Background:

Past experience has shown that attending an AA meeting on the outside the day of release from prison is one of the most effective tools for an inmate to maintain continued sobriety.

It is strongly recommended that an inmate who is an AA member have an AA contact on the outside [preferably with at least one year's sobriety and of the same sex] to meet on the day of release and accompany them to their first few meetings.
